The nine options are:

Care covers activities to help learners understand care provision and the types of work associated with it.

Construction includes a virtual 3-D building site where the learner acts as the site manager.

Construction Small Business Management gives learners a grounding in the key things needed to get their business on the road.

Creativity helps learners generate new ideas and explores the potential of those they already have.

Return to Learning shows learners some new ways of studying that may be totally different to the way they've learned before.

Return to Work covers activities to help learners with the skills they need to get back to work including CV preparation, interview techniques and application skills.

Teleskills gives learners an idea of what's involved in a career in teleskills.

Time Management covers activities to help learners understand how to manage time, develop a plan, overcome challenges and organise time.

Tourism gives learners an idea of what's involved in a career in the tourism industry.

It is recommended that face-to-face sessions are provided to support the tasters.
